### OVERVIEW:

The presenter will provide participants with information on the International Classification of Diseases (ICD)10 Clinical Modification (CM) coding updates that were effective Oct. 1, 2022, for FY 2023 discharge and outpatient services. There are 1,176 new diagnoses codes for FY 2023, including three codes that were added in April 2022, 288 deletions including one deletion in April 2022, and 28 revisions. With so many changes, the presenter will identify areas of focus for attendees.

She looks at ICD-10 training in a purposeful and practical way with the goal of providing functional education to achieve measurable improvement.
