OVERVIEW:

This session will introduce the American Association of Colleges of Nursing New Essentials and Core Competencies for Professional Nursing Education. The presentation will include the foundational elements that guided the development of the Essentials, core concepts, and ten domains for nursing education and practice. The presenter will also include the new two-level model for nursing education in the discussion.

OBJECTIVES:

- Describe the foundational elements of the core competencies for professional nursing education;
- Identify the 10 domains of professional nursing practice;
- Identify the major concepts associated with professional nursing practice; and
- Describe the two levels of the model for professional nursing education.

MEET YOUR FACULTY:

Demetrius Porche, CNS, PhD, FACHE, is the Dean & Professor of the LSU Health Sciences Center School of Nursing and holds an appointment in the School of Public Health and School of Graduate Studies at Louisiana State University Health - New Orleans. Dr. Porche received his undergraduate Bachelor of Science in nursing from Nicholls State University and his Master of Nursing and Doctor of Nursing Science from Louisiana State University Medical Center. He completed Family Nurse Practitioner post-graduate coursework at Concordia University Wisconsin and earned a Doctorate of Philosophy from Capella University in Organization and Management with a specialization in Leadership. Dr. Porche is certified as a Clinical Specialist in Community Health Nursing and Family Nurse Practitioner and is board certified in healthcare by the American College of Healthcare Executives (ACHE). Dr. Porche was inducted as a fellow in the ACHE, the American Academy of Nurse Practitioners, and the American Academy of Nursing. He is currently the Chief Editor of American Journal of Men's Health. In addition, he serves on the editorial board of The Journal for Nurse Practitioners. He is currently a board member of the American Association of Colleges of Nursing.
